Angel Parking on Louisiana Avenue between Stanley & Wortman Avenues: The Street is 65 feet wide and there is angel parking on the west side. The street is a one way going south and not a residential area. The committee voted to approve.

Burger King located at Linden Blvd. and Pennsylvania Avenue: The Tyree Company will install environmental soil remediation system with monitoring wells. Drilling will be from May 24<sup>th</sup> to June 1<sup>st</sup> (14 days) Monday – Friday from 5AM to 11AM. There will be no disruption of traffic and pedestrian access. This is for your information.

The New Lots Merchant Association requested meters to be installed in the area of New Lots Avenue from Warwick Street to Cleveland Street. As a result of their request to DOT, the Bureau of Parking has conducted a survey at the following locations for parking meters.

- New Lots Ave, n/s between Elton Street and Cleveland Street
- New Lots Ave, s/s between Elton Street and Cleveland Street
- New Lots Ave, n/s between Cleveland Street & Ashford Street
- New Lots Ave, n/s between Ashford Street & Warwick Street

It is suggested that the above locations all be 2 hours metered parking as they are currently 2 hours limited parking with the exception of Ashford Street to Warwick Street. The committee is waiting on a letter from the local block associations.

Ruby Weston Manor located at 2237 Linden Blvd. between Ashford & Cleveland Streets want the committee to revisit making Cleveland Street a two way Street. A meeting with the Cleveland Street Block Association is pending.
